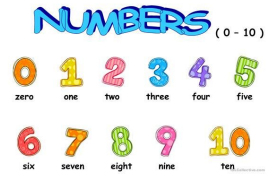

The focus will be on:

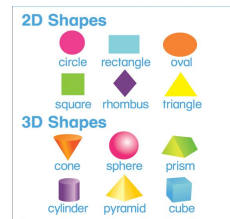
- Engaging in a range of language experiences.
