Writing

The focus will be on:

- Correctly forming all upper and lowercase letters.
- Writing simple sentences with some high-frequency words and beginning sentence structure.
- Begin to use letter-sound knowledge to spell new words.
- Re-read writing to ensure it makes sense.

Speaking and Listening

The focus will be on:

- Engaging in a range of language experiences.
- Shares feelings, opinions and thoughts about the events and characters in texts.
- Deliver short oral presentations to peers, using appropriate voice levels, articulation, body language and eye contact.

Measurement & Geometry

The focus will be on:

- Identifying measurement attributes in practical situations and finding their length, mass and capacity.
- Comparing the length, mass and capacities of familiar objects.



Statistics and Probability

The focus will be on:

- Sorting familiar categorical data into sets and answering yes/no questions about the data.
- Answer simple true/false statements about the data.
